JOINTLY DEVELOPED:

The parents, students, and staff of Lula Elementary School partnered together to develop this school-parent compact for achievement. Teachers suggested home learning strategies, parents added input about the types of support they needed, and students told us what would help them learn. Parents are encouraged to attend annual revision meetings held during Spring each year to review the compact and make suggestions based on student needs and school improvement goals. Parents are also encouraged to participate in the annual Title I parent survey that is also used as a tool to collect parent feedback regarding the current Title I programs and policies. Lula Elementary is committed to helping our parents attend the parental activities. To understand how working together can benefit your child, it is first important to understand the district's and school's goals for student academic achievement.

Hall County School District GOALS:

Goal 1: By the end of FY23, the percentage of students in each subgroup moving into the "Proficient" and "Distinguished" levels of performance on the Georgia Milestones Assessments will increase by 2% in the "Proficient" and "Distinguished" levels of performance.

Goal 2: Increase the percentage of referred students who access school-based mental health services by 2% each year (with FY21 being the baseline year) to decrease the number of OSS days in grades 6-12.

On the 2022-2023 School Improvement Plan, Lula Elementary will:

- By the end of the 2022-2023 school year the number of students performing at or above proficiency in grades 3-5 as measured by the EOG Reading Milestones will increase by 3%.
- By the end of the 2022-2023 school year the number of students performing at or above proficiency in grades 3-5 as measured by the EOG Math Milestones will increase by 3% or exceed as measured by the EOG Georgia Milestones Assessment in Math.

To help your child meet the district and school goals, the school, you, and your child will work together to:

SCHOOL/TEACHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

Lula Elementary School will:

- *Provide opportunities for parents to participate in curriculum based workshops in ELA and math with a variety of activities and games.*
- Offer links to family friendly websites to build reading comprehension skills, as well as math and reading fluency skills.
- Offer monthly newsletters about helping in your child's academic success at home.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

As a parent of a Lula Elementary Student, I will strive to:

- Encourage my child to read at home every night.
- Ask my child to predict what might happen next in a story read.
- Ask who, what, where, when, and why questions about a book.
- Ask my child to write about their favorite part of the story and explain why.
- Help my child practice his/her basic math facts.
- Use strategies taught in workshops to assist my child master the academic standards.

- *Read at home 20 minutes and talk about the book with my family.*
- Write about the favorite part of the story that I read with my family.
- Practice my basic math facts every day.
- Talk with my family about new vocabulary words and what I am learning in Math.
- Use the learning links provided on Launchpoint to improve on mastery of the standards taught in class.
- Use games and activities provided in the workshops to make learning fun at home.
