What is Title I?

Lula Elementary is identified as a Title I school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title I is designed to support State and local school reform efforts tied to the challenging State academic standards to improve teaching and learning for students. Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support family

engagement. All Title I schools must jointly develop with parents and family

members a written parent and family engagement policy.

School Plan for Shared Student Achievement

What is it?

This is a plan that describes how Lula Elementary will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support student learning. Lula Elementary values the contributions and involvement of parents and family members to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. This plan describes the different ways that Lula Elementary will support family engagement and how parents can help plan and participate in activities and events to promote student learning at school and at home.

How is it revised?

Lula Elementary School invited all parents to attend our annual Parent and Family Input meeting last spring to review and revise this parent and family engagement policy, as well as the school wide plan, our school-parent compact, and the family engagement budget. Additionally, parent input and comments regarding this plan are welcome during the school year through an online form. The plan is posted on our school website for parents to view and submit feedback throughout the year. All parent feedback received during the year will be used to revise the plan for the next school year. We also distribute an annual survey online for suggestions on the plan and the use of funds for family engagement. Parents and family members can also give feedback during several parent meetings and activities during the school year.

Who is it for?

All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Lula Elementary will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents and family members with limited English, with disabilities, and of migratory children.

Where is it available?

At the beginning of the year, after revision, the plan is sent out to all parents through Remind. The plan is also posted on the school website. Parents can also retrieve a copy of the plan in the front office upon request.



2023-2024 District Goals

Goal 1: By the end of FY24, the percentage of students in each subgroup moving into the "Proficient" and "Distinguished" levels of performance on the Georgia Milestones Assessments will increase by 2% in the "Proficient" and "Distinguished" levels of performance.

Goal 2: Increase the percentage of referred students who access school-based mental health services by 2% each year (with FY21 being the baseline year) to decrease the number of OSS days in grades 6-12.

2023-2024 School Goals

By the end of FY 2024, the percentage of students meeting projected Reading growth as measured by MAP will be at least 50% (11% increase).

By the end of FY 2024, the percentage of students meeting projected Math growth as measured by MAP will be at least 60% (5% increase).

During FY2024, 100% of homerooms will implement Sources of Strength lessons weekly with fidelity as measured by lesson plans.

School-Parent Compacts

As part of this plan, Lula Elementary and our families will develop a school-parent compact, which is an agreement that parents, teachers, and students will develop that explains how parents and teachers will work together to make sure all our students reach grade-level standards. The compacts will be reviewed and updated annually based on feedback from parents, students, and teachers. The School Parent Compact is available on the school website and distributed through Remind, as well as shared at the annual Title I Meeting. Copies are also available in the front office.
