Reading

- Read a book at your house for 20 min & write a summary about what you have read.
- Look through a book or magazine & find three words that you aren't familiar with. Try to define them using your context clues
- Search through books & magazines to find words with different suffixes (-ed, -ing, -ly, -ful). Write them down and identify the root word and the suffix.

Phonics

- Write a sentence for each of your spelling words
- Write your spelling words in cursive
- Create a column chart and categorize your spelling words based on how many letters they have

Math

- Write 4 word problems that your classmates could solve. Your word problems may include multiplication, division, addition, or subtraction.
- Write your multiplication facts for numbers 1-12.
- Think of 7 different improper fractions & convert them into mixed numbers

Writing

- Tell a story about a pair of lost mittens who find themselves in a winter adventure.
- Respond to this opinion prompt: "What is the best way to spend a snow day?"
- What would your dream classroom look like? Be creative and descriptive!

- Write a paragraph about the importance of Martin Luther King
- Record the temperature and weather conditions from 8am to 2pm
- Observe, illustrate, & label the different clouds that you see outside.
