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What is Title I?

Lula Elementary is identified as a Title I school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title I is designed to support State and local school reform efforts tied to the challenging State academic standards to improve teaching and learning for students. Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support families. All Title I schools must jointly develop with parents and family members a written parent and family engagement policy.

School Plan for Shared Student Achievement

What is it?

This is a plan that describes how Lula Elementary will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support student learning. Lula Elementary values the contributions and involvement of parents and family members to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. This plan describes the different ways that Lula Elementary will support family engagement and how parents can help plan and participate in activities and events to promote student learning at school and at home.

How is it revised?

Lula Elementary School invited all parents to attend our annual Parent and Family Input meeting last spring to review and revise this parent and family engagement policy, as well as the schoolwide plan, our school-parent compact, and the family engagement budget. Additionally, parent input and comments regarding this plan are welcome during the school year through an online form. The plan is posted on our school website for parents to view and submit feedback throughout the year. All parent feedback received during the year will be used to revise the plan for the next school year. We also distribute an annual survey online for suggestions on the plan and the use of funds for family engagement. Parents and family members can also give feedback during several parent meetings and activities during the school year.

Who is it for?

All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Lula Elementary will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents and family members with limited English, with disabilities, and migratory children.

Where is it available?

At the beginning of the year, after revision, the plan is sent out to all parents through Parent Square. The plan is also posted on the school website. Parents can also retrieve a copy of the plan in the front office upon request.

District Goals 2026-2027

Goal 1: By the end of FY27, the overall CCRPI score for HCSD will increase by 2 points from the previous year's overall score, demonstrating measurable improvement in school performance across content mastery, progress, closing gaps, graduation rate, and readiness.

Goal 2: By the end of FY27, the district will implement and monitor targeted strategies that strengthen the overall well-being of students and staff as evidenced by an increase in Georgia School Climate Rating by 1%.

School Goals 2026-2027

Goal 1: By the end of FY27, the overall CCRPI score for Lula Elementary will increase by 2 points from the previous year's overall score, demonstrating measurable improvement in school performance across content mastery, progress, closing gaps, and readiness.

Goal 2: By the end of FY27, Lula Elementary will implement and monitor targeted social-emotional learning and behavioral support strategies that strengthen student well-being, as evidenced by a 25% decrease in the percentage of students demonstrating internalizing and/or externalizing behaviors, as measured by Universal Screener data.

- Partner with early childhood programs, middle and high schools, college and career-ready resources or organizations, parent resource centers, or other programs (as applicable) to help prepare parents and their children for successful school transitioning.
- Communicate with all families and the community on a regular basis regarding schoolwide events and activities through phone messages, social media, and flyers.

- Partner with Head Start through the District Parent Outreach Facilitator. - Participate in Canvas professional development modules at least four times per year to educate staff on strategies to improve communication with parents and ideas to increase family engagement.
